

The coaching workshop: Evidence-based coaching skills for rehabilitation professionals









Target audience: Occupational therapists, physiotherapists, allied health assistants, nurses and exercise physiologists. No pre-requisites.

Overview: This workshop will summarise research about attention, demonstration, instructions, cues, goals, feedback and motivation as they relate to adult neuro-rehabilitation and aged care, and people with intellectual disability/cognitive impairments. Video examples will be used for analysis. Participants will practice and receive feedback on their coaching skills during the workshop.

Learning objectives: Participants will learn how to:

- **Discriminate** between instructions, cues, goals and feedback
- Use goal-directed instructions to encourage and motivate learners
- Provide critical and timely feedback
- Motivate people who have difficulty concentrating or dislike exercise
- Adapt the environment and coaching strategies to enable high repetitions
- · Provide and receive peer review about coaching
