
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Evidence-Based Upper Limb Retraining after Stroke

Upper Limb

Content: This 3-day workshop teaches therapists how to reduce impairments such as weakness and lack of coordination and improve upper limb recovery. Tasks trained include reaching for a cup, picking up a pen to write, and cutlery use. Clinical sessions with stroke survivors enable therapists to implement new knowledge and skills, and practice effective coaching. A focus on intensity and measurement in these sessions show that stroke survivors can improve motor performance regardless of time post-stroke.

Target audience: Physiotherapists, occupational therapists and allied health assistants from hospital and community-based settings, who teach adults following stroke / acquired brain impairment.
